Die Ecke Arte Contemporáneo announces the exhibition **CULTIVO ZONIFICADO (ZONE CROPS)** by **Julen Birke**. The exhibition will be inaugurated with a private view on May 29th at 7:30pm and will remain open to the public until Friday, July 3rd.

Julen Birke's exhibition delves into the imagery of agriculture and the zoning of urban spaces. The exhibition includes six volumes (structures) holding a "culture" of 240 lettuces in their intermediate stage of development. Planted approximately two months ago in the artist's studio, these lettuces will continue to grow inside the gallery until they complete their natural cycle. The fact that this work began in the artist's studio has made it possible to monitor the growth process step-by-step, as if preparing the "material" for the execution of the piece on exhibition.

Together with these volumes, which by nature are in a state of constant change, the artist will place a series of drawings on the walls, referring to cultivation processes and growth systems. At the end of the day, in Julen Birke's work nature becomes an object and that object, in turn, becomes a work of art. The exhibition will be open to the public from Monday to Friday between 3:00 and 7:00pm.
